1. Introduction

When Jesus came the first time, he came as the **leading Messiah** and died on the cross for us. At the second coming, he comes again as **King and judge**.

Joh 1,1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

Joh 3,16 For God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten Son **whoever believes in him will not perish**, but has eternal life.

Romans 5:8-10

8 But God's love for us is that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. 9 Rather, since we are now justified by his blood, we will be saved from wrath through him. 10 For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God through the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, are we through **his life will be saved**.

3.5 years: hour of temptation, contractions

Time of seduction of the Antichrist, 1st-6th century Seal plus 7th seal

3.5 years: the tribulation, the most terrible world war, desecration of the temple; consisting of the 7th seal with the 7 trumpets and 7 bowls

2x 3.5 years = corresponds to the 70th week of the year according to the book of Daniel

Flight of the remnant to the mountains, etc.
Return of Jesus as world ruler with the great battle
Judgment of the living
1000 year empire with peace
Satan is bound during this time.

3. Who will be raptured, basis

3.1 Thoughts in advance

With cremation, not an atom is lost, i.e. it doesn't matter whether we are buried or cremated! In certain circles cremation is not accepted. forbidden, especially in legal circles.

The dead will be raptured first and then those who are still alive!

The rapture saves us from the wrath of God.

3.2 Bible passages on the subject of the rapture

1.Thess 4,13-15

13 But we do not want to leave you ignorant, brothers, about those who have fallen asleep, lest you be grieved like the rest who have no hope.

14 For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, so will God **bring those who have fallen asleep with him through Jesus**. 15 For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord will by no means precede those who have fallen asleep.

Phil 3,20-21

20 Because **our citizenship is in heaven**, from **whence we also look for the Lord Jesus Christ as Savior**21 our body of lowliness **will be redesigned to be conformed to his body of glory**, according to the effective power with which he is able to subdue all things to himself.

1.Thess 5,1-2

1 But as to times and times, brothers, you have no need for it to be written to you. 2 For you yourselves know well that **the day of the Lord comes like a thief in the night**.

At 3,4-5

4 For the children of Israel remain **many days** without king and without ruler, without sacrifice and without memorial stone and without ephod and teraphim. 5 **Then the children of Israel will return** and they shall seek the LORD their God, and David their king. 1 But know this, that in the **difficult times have occurred in recent days** become;

Mt 24.30 And then will the sign of the Son of Man appearing in heaven; and then all the tribes of the land will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming in the clouds of heaven with great power and glory.

Yes 27,13 And on that day it will come to pass, there will be one **big horn pushed** will, and the **Lost in the land of Ashur and the displaced people in the land of Egypt** will come and the **worship LORD** on the holy Berg in Jerusalem.

Mt 24,36 But no one knows about that day and that hour, not even the angels in heaven, **neither does the son, but the father alone.**

Off 1,3 **Blessed is the one who reads and hears the words of prophecy and keeps them**, what is written in it! Because the time is near.

1. Above 15,15-34 The hope of the resurrection versus the denial of the resurrection

15 But we are also found to be false witnesses to God, because we have testified against God that he raised up Christ, whom he did not raise, when the dead are not raised. 16 For if the dead are not raised, neither has Christ been raised. 17 **But if Christ has not been raised, your faith is vain**, then you are still in your sins. 18 So they also who fell asleep in Christ perished. 19 If we have hoped in Christ in this life alone, we are the most miserable of all men. 20 **But now Christ has been raised from the dead**, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep; 21 For since through a man came death, so also through a man did the resurrection of the dead. 22 For as in Adam all die, **so also in Christ all become alive** be made. 23 **But each in their own order**: <the> firstfruits, Christ; then those who belong to Christ at his coming;

24 then the end, when he delivers the kingdom to the God and Father; when he has put away all dominion and all violence and power. 25 Because **he must rule**,

until he has put all enemies under his feet. 26 Death is eliminated as the last enemy. 27 "For he has put everything under his feet." But when it is said that everything is subjected, it is clear that he who has subjected everything to him is excluded. 28 But if all things are subjected to him, then the Son himself will also be subjected to him who subjected all things to him, **that God may be all in all**. 29 Otherwise what will those who are baptized for the dead do? If the dead are not raised at all, why are they baptized for them? 30 Why are we also in danger every hour? 31 I die daily, as you are my glory, brothers, whom I have in Christ Jesus our Lord. 32 If I have fought with wild beasts in Ephesus according to men, what does it profit me? If the dead are not raised, then "let us eat and drink, for tomorrow we die"! 33 Do not be mistaken: **Bad company spoils good morals**. 34 **Sober up righteously and do not sin!** For some are ignorant of God; I tell you to shame.

1. Above 15,51 Behold, I tell you one thing **Secret** We will not all fall asleep, but we will all be changed,

Off 3,10 Because you have kept the word of waiting for me, I also will keep you from the hour of temptation that is coming upon all the face of the earth, to try those who dwell on the earth.

Joh 17,25 Righteous Father! - And the world did not recognize you; But I have recognized you, and they have recognized that you have sent me.

4. What gives us certainty and trust

4.1 Jesus' statements to us

You are in the world, but not of the world!

Joh 7,37-38

37 But on the last day of the feast, the great day, Jesus stood and cried and said, **If anyone is thirsty, let him come to me and drink!** 38 **Whoever believes in me**, as the Scripture has said, **Rivers of living water will flow from his body**.

Joh 15,19 If you were of the world, the world would love its own; but because you are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, **therefore the world hates you**.

Joh 17,16 They (the believers) are not of the world, as I am not of the world.

Joh 17,18 As you sent me into the world, so have I sent them into the world;

Mt 11,28 Come to me, all you who labor and are heavy laden! And I will give you rest.

1.Tim 2,3-4

3 This is good and acceptable in the sight of our Savior God, 4 who wants that **all people will be saved** and come to the knowledge of the truth.

Joh 14,1-6 Departure to the Father and Second Coming - Revelation of the Father

1 Do not let your hearts be troubled[a]. You believe in God, believe in me too! 2 In my father's house **are many apartments**. If it were not so, would I have said to you, I am going to prepare a place for you? 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and **I will take you to me, so that you too may be where I am**. 4 And wherever I go, you know the way. 5 Thomas said to him, "Lord, we do not know where you are going. And how can we know the way?"

6 Jesus says to him: **I am the way and the truth and the life.**

No one comes to the Father except through me.

1 The **trust in the LORD**, are like Mount Zion, which **doesn't waver**, the remains forever. 2 Jerusalem - mountains are all around it. **So is the LORD all around his people, from now on until eternity.**

Spr 18,10 **A solid tower** is the name of the LORD; to him the righteous runs and is safe.

Joel 3,5 And it will happen: **Everyone who calls on the name of the LORD will be saved.** For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there will be salvation, as the LORD has spoken, and among those who remain whom the LORD will call.

4.2 Our mission

Mt 28,19 Now go there and **makes disciples of all nations**, and baptize them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

12 Verily, verily, I say to you, **Whoever believes in me**, he will too **do the works**, which I do, and **will do bigger than this**, because I go to the father. 13 And **whatever you shall ask in my name, that will I do**, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

Blessing and curse that is still valid and effective today!

5. Share of world history

5.1 Important historical dates before Christ

The exodus from slavery in Egypt was in 1606 BC by Moses on God's behalf
After 430 years of slavery
Captured by the Assyrians in 721 BC
In 612 BC Nineveh fell because of disloyalty/disobedience
605-539 BC Babylonian rule
539-331vChr Medo-Persian Reich
In 312 BC the Greek ruler was Alexander the Great
331-168 BC Greek Empire
31 BC was the last battle of the Greeks

According to the book of Malachi, the Bible is silent for 400 years, until the birth of Jesus.
Alexander the Great ruled the world.

That's why Greek was the world language back then.

At that time, God needed the Septuagint (70 studied) to translate the Bible from
Aramaic/Hebrew into Greek.

Aramaic/Hebrew have up to 12 possible expressions for one word.

Aramaic/Hebrew have no consonants.

That's why it was translated, because Greek has many more words and can describe
more.

5.2 Prophecies in the book of Daniel

According to the book of Daniel, 69 weeks passed before the birth of Jesus.
(see script and statue from Book of Daniel)

So we come to the book of Daniel, with feet of iron and toes of clay. (Iron is symbolic of
the Roman Empire, back then, strong as iron and fragile as clay)

Daniel described (600 BC) the 4 world empires, at that time: Assyria, Persian, Greek and
Roman Empires.

The feet of iron and clay (the Roman Empire; from the script Daniel)

The iron legs of the statue finally lead into the feet made of iron and clay. Daniel's
explanation of the feet shows that we are dealing here with the successor states of the
Roman Empire. He gives us in the following verses
3 different interpretations, all of which are fully valid.

1) Fragmentation

Dan 2.41a And that you saw the feet and the toes partly of potter's clay and partly of iron
= it will be a divided kingdom;

The Roman Empire was mighty and strong as iron, but it began to decay more and more.
The Western Roman Empire collapsed in the 5th century AD.

Due to the invasion of the barbarian hordes in the 4th/5th century. Century, the Roman
Empire became more and more fragmented. This led to the formation of many small,
separate kingdoms. Europe became one through the constant splitting up of its former
unity

continent characterized by disruption.

The Eastern Roman Empire lasted longer, but became increasingly weaker over the
centuries until it finally collapsed completely in 1453 AD. Daniel says this in:

Dan 2.41bbut the strength of iron will be in him, because you saw the iron mixed with
loamy clay.

2) Strength and Weakness

Dan 2:42 And the toes of the feet, part of iron, and part of clay: part of the kingdom shall
be strong, and part of it shall be broken.

He is talking about the final phase here. One side is strong like iron, the other is weak and fragile like clay. Western Europe is extremely strong economically, in contrast to Eastern Europe. The West is focused on integration and in the East there are massive contrary ideals that result in decomposition and fragmentation (z.B. Ex-Yugoslavian, UDSSR, CSSR etc.).

3) Mixing of peoples

Dan 2:43 That thou sawest iron mixed with loamy clay - they shall mingle with the seed of men, but they shall not adhere together: even as iron mixeth not with clay. Today in Europe we are experiencing large flows of people from Eastern Europe and other peoples seeking asylum. Daniel foresaw that this would result in a mixture of peoples, but without complete cohesion.

4) The stone brings the turning point

Dan 2:44 And in the days of these kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom which will not be destroyed for ever, and which will not be given over to any other people; It will crush and destroy all those kingdoms, but it will itself endure forever: 45 Because you saw that from the mountain a stone was torn away without hands, and it crushed to pieces the iron, the bronze, the clay, the silver, and the gold. The great God has made known to the king what will happen after this; and the dream is certain and its interpretation reliable

(The New Eternal (Eonic) Kingdom of God).

6. History of Israel / Jews

6.1 World history from 70 AD with the destruction of the temple

The earlier historical sequence can be read in the Bible.

Since the outpouring of the Holy Spirit will live in **Age of the church**.

In 70 AD the Temple was destroyed by the Romans and the Jews were driven out of Israel and scattered throughout the world. = Templeless time

In 73 AD, Massada fell to the Romans, with around 1,000 dead, the last bastion of the Jews, but it was not a victory in the sense that everyone killed themselves to avoid being captured. Signs were enough supplies left over.

In 73 AD the Greeks were destroyed

168BC – 476AD Roman Empire

460AD phiel Rom

In 632 AD, Mohammed died and the Muslims advanced against Jerusalem.

His big competitor was his brother and brother-in-law at the same time.

The Dome of the Rock in Jerusalem was built in 638 AD as a tomb for Mohammed. At the beginning of the 8th century, the mosque was built exactly on the spot where the temple stood, facing Mecca. This meant that Jews were forbidden to enter.

The Alaksam Mosque is there today and an underground mosque was also built for a few thousand people. So there are 3 mosques in a prominent place that prevent the construction of the temple in its original location.

Deuteronomy 28:64-67 Dispersion! all over the world after the destruction of the temple

64 And the LORD will you **scatter among all nations from one end of the earth to the other end of the earth**. And you will serve other gods there, whom you did not know, neither you nor your fathers - gods of wood and stone. 65 And **you will not dwell quietly among those nations**, and the sole of your foot will **can't find a rest area**. And the

LORD will give you there a trembling heart, and a fainting eye, and a fainting soul. 66 And **your life will be in danger, you will be afraid night and day and unsure of your life.** 67 In the morning you will say: If only it were evening! and in the evening you will say: If only it were morning! - **because of the trembling of your heart**, with which you tremble, and because of the sight of what your eyes <must> see.

6. The Beast from the Sea (Dictator of the West, expansion of Europe is USA, Canada, expansion Spain, Portugal = South America)

Off 12,18-13,18 The beast from the sea and the beast from the earth

18 And he stood on the sand of the sea.

Off 13,1 And I saw **from the sea** **Tier** rise, that **ten horns and seven heads** had, and on his horns **ten tiaras** and on their heads **names of blasphemy**. **2** And the beast which I saw was like a leopard, and his feet like the mouth of a bear, and his mouth like the mouth of a lion. And the dragon gave him his strength and his throne and great power. **3** And <I saw> one of his heads as if slaughtered to death. And his deadly wound was healed, and all the earth marveled after the beast. **4** And they worshiped the dragon because of him **gave the animal power**, and her **prayed to the animal** and said, Who is like the beast? And who can fight with him? **5** And there was given him a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies; and it **he was given power, 42 Fun to work**. **6** And he opened his mouth shut **Blasphemies against God** to blaspheme his name and his tabernacle and those who dwell in heaven. **7** And it was given unto him to make war

with the saints, and to overcome them; and **he was given power** about every tribe and every people and every language and every nation. 8 And all who dwell on the earth will worship him, **<everyone> whose name is not written in the book of life** of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.

A) The animal refers to a male person

9 If anyone has an ear, let him hear. 10 If anyone goes into captivity, he goes into captivity; If anyone is killed with the sword, he must be killed with the sword. Here is the endurance and faith of the saints.

Let him who has understanding (understanding) calculate the number of the beast! Because it is a **person's number**; and his number is 666.

18 Here is wisdom. Let him who has understanding (understanding) calculate it **number of the animal**! For it is a man's number; and its number is **666**.

Antichrist gives power to the beast

Make a covenant with Israel as security for a certain time and then break the covenant

Yes 28,14-22

14 Therefore hear the word of the LORD, you men of boasting, rulers of this people that are in Jerusalem. 15 For you say, We have made a covenant with death and a covenant with Sheol. When the flooding scourge passes through, it will not reach us, for we have made lies our refuge and sheltered ourselves in deceit. 16 Therefore, thus says the Lord

GOD: Behold, I am laying in Zion a foundation stone, a tried stone, a precious cornerstone, founded as a rock. Whoever believes in him will not hasten <fearfully>. 17 And I will make justice the rule, and righteousness the balance. Hail will sweep away the refuge of lies, and the waters will wash away the hiding place. 18 And your covenant with death will be abolished, and your covenant with Sheol will not stand. When the flooding scourge passes through, you will be trampled underfoot by it. 19 Whenever it passes through, it will overtake you; for it will pass through morning after morning, day and night. Then it will be sheer terror to get the message across. 20 For the bed is too short to stretch out, and the blanket is too narrow to cover oneself. 21 For the LORD will rise up as he did in mount Perazim, as in the valley of Gibeon he will rage, to do his work. **His work is strange** - and to do his work; **his work is strange**. 22 Now therefore, do not mock, lest your bonds be made stronger. Because I have from **determined destruction** heard by the Lord GOD of hosts throughout all the earth.

10.4 Pouring out of the seven bowls of wrath, depending on the 7th trumpet

Off 16,1-21

1 And I heard a loud voice coming from the temple to them **seven angels** say: Go and water them **seven bowls of the wrath of God poured out on the earth**. 2 And that **first** went and watered **his shell** out to earth; and a was created **evil and bad ulcer** to the people who do that **mark of the beast and worshiped his image**. 3 And that **second** poured his **Peel** out on that **More**; and it became <to> **blood** as if from a dead person, and **every living soul died**, <everything> that was in the sea. 4 And that **third** poured his **Peel** out on the **streams** and the **Water sources**, and it became <to> **blood**. 5 And I heard the angel of the waters saying, Thou art righteous, he that is and was, the Holy One, that thou hast judged thus. 6 For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets, and you have given them blood to drink; they are worth it. 7 And I heard the altar saying, Yea, O Lord God Almighty, true and righteous are thy judgments. 8 And that **fourth** poured his **Peel** out on the **Sun**; and it was given to her, which **To scorch people with fire**. 9 And the people were of **scorched by great heat** and blasphemed the name of God, who has power over these plagues, and **they did not repento** give him honor. 10 And that **fifth** poured his **Peel** out on the **Throne of the Beast**; and became his kingdom **verfinstert**; and her **bit their tongues in pain** 11 And they blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and because of them **Ulcers**, and they did not repent of their works. 12 And that **sixth** poured his **Peel** out for the big ones **River Euphrates**; and its water **dried up, so that the way of kings was prepared from the sunrise**. 13 And I looked out of that **Dragon's Mouth** and from that **mouth of the animal** and from that **Mouth of the false prophet three unclean spirits** <come>, like frogs; 14 For they are spirits of demons, doing signs, going out to the kings of all the world to gather them together **the war of God's great day**, the Almighty. 15 - See, **I come like a thief**[a]. **Blessed is he who watches**[b] And he kept his clothes, lest he go about naked, and his shame not be seen. - 16 And he gathered them together to the place called Armageddon in Hebrew. A) i.e. Mount of Megiddo (site of important battles in Israel's Old Testament history) 17 And that **seventh** poured his **Peel** out into the air; and there came a loud voice out of the temple from the throne, saying, It is come to pass. 18 And there were lightnings, and voices, and thunders; and a **big earthquake** happened, the like of which has not happened since a human being was on earth, such a powerful, such a great earthquake. 19 And the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell, and the great city of Babylon was remembered before God to give her the cup of the wine of the fury of his wrath.

A) perhaps a coded name for Rome

20 And **every island disappeared and mountains were not found.** 21 And a great hail, weighing a hundred pounds, fell out of heaven upon the people; and the **People blasphemed God** because of the plague of the hail, for its plague is very great.

11. End time speeches

11.1 Parable of the faithful and unfaithful servant

Mt 24,45-51 (Lk 12,41-46)

45 Who then is the faithful and wise servant whom his master has appointed over his servants to give them food at the proper time? 46 Blessed is that servant whom his master, when he comes, will find doing such a thing! 47 Verily I say to you, he will set him over all his possessions. 48 But if that evil servant says in his heart, "My lord is waiting for him," 49 and begins to beat his fellow servants and eat and drink with drunkards, 50 then the lord of that servant will come in one day, when he does not expect it, and in an hour which he does not know, 51 And he will cut him in two, and appoint him his portion with the hypocrites: there will be weeping, and this be gnashing of teeth.

11.2 Parable of the ten virgins

Mt 25,1-13

1 Then the kingdom of heaven will be like ten virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom. 2 But five of them were foolish and five were wise. 3 For the foolish took their lamps and took no oil with them; 4 But the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps. 5 But when the bridegroom waited for him, they all became drowsy and fell asleep.

6 At midnight there was a shout: Behold the bridegroom! Go out and meet him! 7 Then all those virgins stood up and decorated their lamps. 8 But the foolish said to the wise, Give us some of your oil. Because our lamps are going out. 9 But the wise answered and said, No, lest there be not enough for us and for you. Better go to the sellers and buy for yourself!

10 And as they went to buy, the bridegroom came, and those who were ready went in with him to the wedding; and the door was locked. 11 And later the rest of the virgins also come and say, Lord, Lord, open to us! 12 But he answered and said, Verily I say to you, I do not know you. 13 Watch now! For you know neither the day nor the hour.

11.3 Parable of the entrusted talents

Mt 25,14-30 (cf. Page 19,11-27)

14 For it is like a man who went out of the country, calling his own servants and giving them his possessions. 15 And to one he gave five talents, to another two, to another one, to each according to his ability , and traveled out of the country. 16 Immediately the one who had received the five talents went and traded with them and won another five talents. 17 So he who received the two also gained the other two. 18 But he who had received one went and dug a hole in the ground and hid his master's money. 19 But after a long time the master of those servants comes and settles accounts with them. 20 And he that had received the five talents came near, and brought another five talents, and said, Lord, thou hast given me five talents; behold, I have gained another five talents. 21 His master said to him, "That's right, good and faithful servant! You were faithful over a few things, I will set you over many things; enter into the joy of your Lord. 22 And the one who had received the two talents came near and said, Lord, you have given me two talents; Behold, I have gained two other talents. 23 His master said to him, "That's right, good and faithful servant! You were faithful over a few things, I will set you over many things; enter into the joy of your Lord. 24 And the one who had received the one talent came near and said, Lord, I knew you to be a hard man: you reap where you did not sow, and gather where you did not scatter; 25 And I was afraid, and went and hid your talent in

the ground; Behold, there you have yours. 26 But his lord answered and said to him, Wicked and slothful servant! You knew that I reap where I did not sow and gather where I did not scatter? 27 So you should have given my money to the money changers, and when I came I would have received mine with interest. 28 Now take away the talent from him and give it to him who has the ten talents. 29 For to every one that hath it shall be given, and it shall be abounded; but from him who has not, even what he has will be taken away. 30 And cast out the useless servant into the outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

11.4 The Court

Mt 25,31-46

31 But when the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, he will sit on his throne of glory; 32 And all nations will be gathered before him, and he will separate them one from another, as the shepherd separates the sheep from the goats. A) i.e. billy goats; Sheep and goats were pastured together and separated from the shepherd for the night.

33 And he will put the sheep on his right hand, and the goats on the left. 34 Then the King will say to those on his right hand, Come, blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world. 35 For I was hungry, and you gave me something to eat; I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink; I was a stranger and you welcomed me; 36 naked, and you clothed me; I was sick and you came to see me; I was in prison and you came to me. 37 Then the righteous will answer him and say, Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you? Or thirsty and gave you something to drink? 38 But when did we see you as a stranger and welcome you? Or naked and clothed? 39 But when did we see you sick or in prison and come to you? 40 And the king will answer and say to them, Verily I say to you, inasmuch as you did it to one of the least of these my brethren, you did it to me. 41 Then he will also say to those on the left, Depart from me, you accursed ones, into the everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angels. 42 For I was hungry, and you gave me no food; I thirsted, and you gave me no drink; 43 I was a stranger and you did not receive me; naked, and you did not clothe me; sick and in prison, and you did not visit me. 44 Then they also will answer and say, Lord, when did we see you hungry, or thirsty, or a stranger, or naked, or sick, or in prison, and did not serve you? 45 Then he will answer them and say, Verily I say to you what you **If you have not done it to one of the least of these, you have not done it to me.** 46 And these shall go away to eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life.

11.5 Arrival of the Son of Man

Mt 24,29-31

(Mk 13,24-27; Lk 21,25-27)

29 But immediately after the trouble of those days, **Sonne verfinstert** become and the **Moon does not give its light**, and the **Stars will fall from the sky**, and the powers of the heavens will **shocked** become. 30 And then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven; and then all the tribes of the land will lament, and **They will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with great power and glory**. 31 And he will send his angels with him **loud trumpet sound**, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of the heavens to the other end.

12. Sign of the times, recognize the signs

12.1 Overview of predictions according to Mt 24; Mark 13; Luke 21: starting from 1882 to today and continuing...

- World wars, revolutions, mass deaths of animals
- Persecution of Christians around the globe
- Storm surges, earthquakes, wildfires, earthquakes, tornadoes, hurricanes
- Famines, epidemics, pandemics, like Corona
- Terrorism, horror events
- Many false prophets, false messiahs and great signs and wonders
- Forced mass waste, voluntary mass waste
- Massive moral decay
- The gospel reaches all nations

12.2 False Christs and false prophets

Mt 24,4-13

4 And Jesus answered and said to them, **See to it that no one seduces you!**

5 Because **many will come under my name** and say: I am the Christ! And **they will deceive many**. 6 But you will be of **Hear wars and rumors of wars**. Watch, don't be frightened! Because it has to happen, but it is not the end yet. 7 For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom, and there will be famines and earthquakes here and there. 8 **But all of this is the beginning of labor pains**. 9 Then they will deliver you up to trouble and kill you; and **you will be hated by all nations because of my name**.

10 And then many will be led astray, and will betray one another, and hate one another; 11 and **many false prophets will arise** and will deceive (mislead) many; 12 and because the **Lawlessness prevails**, becomes **love** of most **cool down**; 13 **but whoever endures to the end will be saved**.

2. Above 11,3 But I'm afraid that, like that **The serpent seduced Eve with his cunning**, perhaps your mind is turned away from simplicity and integrity toward Christ and is corrupted.

2.Thess 2,1-8 The coming of Christ and the great deceiver who preceded it

1 But we beseech you, brethren, because of the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our union with him, 2 that ye do not be quickly shaken in your minds, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter, as if they were sent from us, as if the **Lord's Day** there would be. 3 Let no one deceive you in any way. For <that day will not come> unless **the waste came first** and the **Man of lawlessness** the son of perdition has been revealed; 4 who opposes and exalts himself above everything that is called God or is the object of worship, so that **he sits down in the temple of God** and proves that **he is God**. 5 Do you not remember that I said these things to you while I was still with you? 6 And now you know what holds back, that he may be revealed in his own time. 7 For the mystery of lawlessness is already at work; only <it does not reveal itself> until **the one who is now holding back is out of the way**; 8 And then the lawless one will be revealed, whom the Lord Jesus will destroy with the breath of his mouth and destroy with the appearance of his coming;

1.Joh 2,20-28

20 And ye have the anointing of the Holy One, and have all knowledge. 21 I have not written to you because you do not know the truth, but because you know it and know that no lie comes from the truth. 22 Who is the liar but he who denies that Jesus is the Christ? **He is the Antichrist who denies the Father and the Son**. 23 **Anyone who denies the Son does not have the Father either; He who confesses the Son also has the Father**.

Off 5,6 And I saw in the midst of the throne and of the four living creatures and in the midst of the elders a Lamb standing as if it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes; they are **the seven spirits of God**, sent out throughout the whole earth.

Be ready, for he comes like a thief in the night!

12.3 Pay attention to the signs

Israel is the standard of signs, as another verse says, the stumbling bowl for the nations!

Symbolized like this:

- **the vine Israel's spiritual condition**
- **the olive tree is Israel's religious state**
- **the fig tree Israel's national condition**

1. Joh 2,18 Children, it is the last hour, and as you have heard that the Antichrist is coming, so are you now **many antichrists** occurred[b]; therefore we know that **it's the last hour.**

Mt 24,14-21

14 And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world for a witness to all nations, and then the end will come. 15 Now if you **Abomination of desolation** which was spoken of by Daniel the prophet, **see standing in a holy place** - whoever reads it, pay attention! - 16 Then those in Judea will leave **the mountains flee**; 17 **Whoever is on the roof should not go down to get the <things> from his house**; 18 and **whoever is in the field shall not return** to get his coat. 19 But woe to those who are pregnant and to those who are nursing in those days! 20 But pray that yours **Escape** let it not happen in winter nor on the Sabbath! 21 For then will **great distress** be, **such as it has not been from the beginning of the world until now and never will be.**

Off 13,8 And all who dwell on the earth will worship him[A], **<everyone> whose name is not written in the book of life** of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world. A) the animal means a male person

Off 13,14-15

14 and **it seduces them** who live on earth **because of the signs that before the beast was given to him to do**, and it tells those who dwell on the earth to make an image of the beast that has the wound of the sword and has come to life. 15 And it was given to him **to give breath to the image of the beast**, so that **the image of the beast even spoke and caused everyone to be killed** who did not worship the image of the beast.

Sach 14,3-5

3 Then the LORD will go out and fight against those nations, as he always fought on the day of battle. 4 And his feet will stand on that day on the Mount of Olives, which is east of Jerusalem; and the Mount of Olives will be removed **split from its center to the east and to the west** to a very large valley, and the **<one half of the mountain will move to the north and the other half to the south**. 5 And you will flee to the valley of my mountains, and the valley of the mountains will reach to Azal. And **you will flee** how you fled from the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah. **Then the LORD my God will come, and all the saints with him.**

Revelation 16:20

And every island disappeared, and No mountains were found.

Sach 11,9-11

9 Then I said: **I don't want to hurt you anymore.** What dies may die, and what perishes may perish; and those who remain shall eat one another's flesh. 10 And I took my staff "kindness" and **break it to make my covenant void**, which I had concluded with all peoples. 11 So it was invalidated that day. And the sheep traders who looked after me recognized that it was the word of the LORD.

Sach 13,8-9

8 And it will **happening across the countrysays** the LORD, **two parts of it will be eradicated**, different, and **<only> the third part of it remains**. 9 And I bring **the third part into the fire, purify it**, how to refine the silver, and test them as one tries the gold[b]. He will call on my name, and I will answer him, I will say, He is my people. And he will say, The LORD is my God.

Sach 12,10 But concerning the house of David, and concerning the inhabitants of Jerusalem **I pour out the spirit of grace** and of supplication, and **they will look upon me whom they have pierced**, and will lament over him, as one over who lament for their only son, and will weep bitterly over him, as one bitterly over the firstborn weeps.

2 Peter 3.9 The Lord does not delay the promise, as some consider delay, but is longsuffering toward you, not wanting any to perish but for all to come to repentance.

1 Joh 2,24-28

24 You! What you have heard from the beginning, remain within you! **If** If what you heard from the beginning remains in you, you also will remain in the Son and in the Father.

25 And this is the promise he promised us: eternal life.

26 I have written these things to you in view of those who deceive you. 27 And you! **The anointing you received from him remains within you**, and you have no need for anyone to teach you, but as his anointing teaches you about everything, so it is true and not a lie. And as she taught you, abide in him! 28 And now, children, abide in him, so that when he is revealed we may have boldness and not be put to shame before him at his coming.

12.4 The corruption of the end times

1 Tim 4:1-3 Exhortation to reject legalistic doctrines

1 But the Spirit expressly says that in later times some will fall away from the faith **deceitful spirits** and **Teachings of Demons** pay attention, 2 through the **Hypocrisy of lying speakers** who are branded in their own conscience, 3 who forbid marriage, and command abstinence from food which God has created for the acceptance with thanksgiving of those who believe and know the truth.

Mt 24,12

12 and because the **Lawlessness prevails**, becomes **the love of most cool down**;

2.Tim 3,1-9

1 But know this, that **difficult times in the last few days** will occur; 2 because **people will be selfish, lovers of money, boastful, haughty, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, ungrateful, unholy, 3 unloving, unforgiving, slanderer, intemperate, cruel, not loving what is good,**

a) Romans 1:29-31

4 traitors, rash, pompous, **loving pleasure more than God**5 Who have a form of godliness, but deny its power. And turn away from these! 6 For of these are those who sneak into houses and seduce loose women, who are burdened with sins and driven by various desires,

7 always learning and never being able to come to the knowledge of the truth. - 8 But as Jannes and Jambres resisted Moses, so they also resist the truth, men corrupt in mind, unproven in the faith. A) according to Jewish Tradition the magicians who performed the miracles of Moses imitated (Ex 7:11,22; 8:3)

9 But they will not advance any further, for their foolishness will become to everyone become apparent, as was the case with those.

12.5 Encouragement to hold fast to the Word of God and for proclamation despite persecution

2.Tim 3,10-4,5

10 But you have followed my teaching, my way of life, my resolution, my faith, my longsuffering, my love, my endurance, 11 my persecutions, my sufferings, which happened to me in Antioch, in Iconium, in Lystra. I endured these persecutions, and the Lord delivered me from them all. 12 But everyone who wants to live godly in Christ Jesus will be persecuted. 13 But evil men and deceivers will progress to worse things, deceiving and being deceived. 14 But you continue in what you have learned and are convinced of, because you know from whom you learned, 15 and because you have known the holy scriptures from childhood, **have the power to make you wise for salvation through faith**, who is in Christ Jesus. 16 **All Scripture is God-breathed and useful for teaching, to Transfer, to Rebuke, to Instruction in justice** 17 that the man of God might be right, **equipped for every good work.**

4,1 I testify earnestly before God and Christ Jesus, who will judge the living and the dead, and at his appearing and his kingdom: 2 Preach the word, standing ready in season and in season; **convict, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and teaching!** 3 For there will be a time when **they cannot tolerate sound doctrine**, but according to theirs **own desires** teachers will pile up on themselves because it tickles their ears; 4 And they will turn away their ears from the truth and turn to fables. 5 But you be sober in everything, enduring suffering, doing the work of an evangelist, **perform your service!**

12.6 Reminder to be vigilant

(Mk 13,28-37; V. 32-35: Lk 21,29-33; V. 37-41: Lk 17,26-35; V. 42-44: Lk 12,39,40)

Mt 24,32-44

32 But learn the parable from the fig tree: When its branch has already become tender and put out its leaves, you know that summer is near.

33 So you also, when you see all these things, know that it is near the door is. 34 Verily I say to you, this generation will not pass away until all these things are done. 35 **Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away.** 36 **But no one knows about that day and that hour**, not even the angels in heaven, **nor the Son, but the Father alone.**

37 **But as the days of Noah were, so will the coming of the Son of Man be.** 38 For as they were in those days before the flood, they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark

39 and they did not know it until the flood came and swept away all, so will it be be the coming of the Son of Man. 40 Then there will be two in the field, **one is taken and one is left;** 41 Two women will grind at the millstone, one will be taken and one will be left. 42 **So watch! For you do not know on what day your Lord is coming.** 43 But know this: If the master of the house had known at what watch[A] the thief was coming, he would have kept watch and not allowed his house to be broken into.

A) In the New Testament. The Greco-Roman period was considered. Division of the night into four watches.

44 That's why you too are ready! For in the hour when you do not think so, the Son of Man will come.

Mt 24,27 For as lightning comes from the east and shines all the way to the west, **so will be the coming of the Son of Man.**

Mal 2:1-9 God's accusation against the priests

Daniel's prayer of repentance and the mystery of the seventy weeks

And 9.1-26

1 In the first year of Darius the son of Ahasuerus, of the family of the Medes, who reigned over the kingdom of the Chaldeans, 2 in the first year of his reign I, Daniel, noted in the scrolls the number of years during which The word of the LORD came to Jeremiah the prophet, saying, **seventy years over the rubble of Jerusalem** should go there[A].

A) w. should be completed for the ruins of Jerusalem

3 And I set my face toward the Lord God, to seek him with prayer and supplication, with fasting and sackcloth and ashes. 4 And I prayed to the LORD my God, and I confessed, saying, O LORD, the great and awesome God, who keepeth covenant and lovingkindness to them that love him, and keep his commandments. 5 We have sinned and transgressed and acted wickedly; we have rebelled and turned away from your commandments and your statutes. 6 And we have not listened to your servants the prophets, who spoke in your name to our kings, to our rulers, to our fathers, and to all the people of the land. 7 With you, O LORD, is righteousness, but with us is the shame of the face, as it is this day: with the men of Judah, and with the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and with all Israel, both near and far away, in all Countries where you have driven them out because of the treachery they have committed against you. 8 LORD! For many will come in my name, saying, I am he, and the time is at hand! Don't go after them! 9 But if you from **Hear wars and outrages** don't be frightened! 33. Construction of the 3rd Temple

33.1. The 3rd Temple and the historical sequence of events

The 3rd Temple is already planned and prepared, and the Jews are waiting for the redemption. All devices have already been created and stored.
But first the mosque has to be destroyed, by whomever.

The tabernacle was built after the exodus from Egypt from the goods that were given to the people at the exodus. It's amazing what they took with them into the desert. This was the walking temple, wandering in the desert.

The tabernacle lasted until Solomon 1005-1013 BC. Since Solomon built the Temple, which was planned by David, it lasted from 1013-586 BC.

Then it was destroyed by the Babylonians and the people were taken into exile.

The 2nd Temple was rebuilt under the rule of the Medo/Persian Empire by King Cyrus 538BC-70AD. This temple was greatly expanded by Herod.

This lasted until it was destroyed by the Romans in 70 AD.

According to Dan 9, 69 weeks had passed until Jesus was born (445 BC-32 AD).

In 32 AD Jesus was tortured and crucified and rejected by the people.

From then on there was no more temple.

With the death of Jesus, the curtain of the Holy of Holies was torn from top to bottom.

This gave us direct access to God.

Mark 15:38 And the curtain of the temple was torn in two **top to bottom**.

The dispersion of the people throughout the world took place from 70 AD to 1882.
That was the first wave of returns to their own country.

So there was no temple left until today.

33.2 The 3rd Temple was already announced in the book of Ezekiel for/into the end times.

Various Bible passages that prove this:

Hes 40-48; Joel 1-2 (can be found in the Bible)

Hes 40,5 And behold, a wall surrounded the temple on all sides; and in the man's hand was a measuring rod of six cubits, <the cubit> as an <ordinary> cubit and the breadth of a hand <calculated>[A]. And he measured the width of the building (thickness of the outer wall): a rod, and the height: a rod.

A) The grosselle described by Ezekiel was 7 handbreadths; that's about 52 cm.

Accordingly, the measuring rod was around 3.10 m long.

Hes 42,15-20

15 And when he had finished measuring the inner house of the temple, he brought me out toward the gate, the front of which was toward the east; and he measured it all around. 16 He measured the east side with the measuring rod, five hundred rods, with the measuring rod. 17 And he turned and measured the north side, five hundred rods, with the measuring rod. And he turned; 18 He measured the south side, five hundred rods with the measuring rod. 19 He turned to the west side and measured five hundred rods with the measuring rod. 20 He measured it according to the four sides. It had a wall around it, five hundred long and five hundred wide, to separate the holy from the unholy.

Sach 6,12 And say to him, Thus says the LORD of hosts: Behold, a man, a Branch, his name is! And it will sprout under him, and **he becomes the temple build the LORD.**

Vision of the future temple: Entry of the glory of LORD - Dedication of the Altar of Burnt Offering

Hes 43,1-4

1 And he led me to the gate, the gate that faces east. 2 And behold, the glory of the God of Israel came from the east; and their sound was like the sound of great waters, and the earth shone with his glory. 3 And the vision that I saw was like the vision that I had seen when he came to destroy the city; and visions like the vision that I saw by the river Chebar. And I fell down on my face. 4 And the glory of the LORD entered into the house by the way of the gate whose front was toward the east.

Ps 46,5 The course of the river makes the city of God glad, the holiest of the dwellings of the Most High.

Hes 47,9 And it will come to pass that every living creature that swarms there - wherever the river (double river) comes - will live. And there will be a lot of fish. When this water comes there, the salt water will become healthy, and everything will live wherever the river comes. = concerns the Dead Sea!

Yes 56,5 To them I will give a place and a name in my house and within my walls, better than sons and daughters. I will give them an everlasting name, which shall not be blotted out.

Yes 66,6 Sound of a roar from the city! Sound from the temple! Sound from the LORD, who takes vengeance on his enemies!

And 9,27 And he will establish a strong covenant for many[A] for a week; and at the halfway point of the week he will stop the sacrifice and the grain offering. And on the wing of abominations comes a desolator, until certain destruction is poured out upon the desolator.

A) o. And the covenant with the many will prove strong. - Others: he will make the covenant difficult for many; i.e. make many people fall away

Joel 4,18 And it shall come to pass on that day, that the mountains shall drip with new wine, and the hills shall flow with milk, and all the streams of Judah shall flow full of water. And a spring shall come forth from the house of the LORD, and shall water the valley of Shittim.

Hag 2:1-9 Future glory of the temple

1 In the seventh month, on the 21st day of the month, the word of the LORD came through Haggai the prophet, saying,

A) others move the last time from 1.15 to 2.1 and above: In the second year of King Darius, in the seventh <month> ...

2 Say now to Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and to Jeshua the son of Jehozadak, the high priest, and to the remnant of the people, saying: A) at the same time a military leader

3 Who is left among you who has seen this house in its former glory? And how do you see it now? Isn't it like nothing in your eyes? 4 Now be strong, Zerubbabel! says the LORD[A]. 34. Open questions - timing

I have no claim to completeness or correct sequence. I put it together as best as I could to the best of my knowledge.

The exact sequence of events is not easy to put together.

Many Bible passages point to this. A lot of things flow together.

Depending on the topic, different Bible passages are used multiple times.

Examples:

When will the population be reduced to a third or the believers survive?

When will the Jewish people convert, because Jesus won't come back before then?

When exactly does the remnant (one third) convert?

This concerns the Jews

(Time unclear, possibly end of the tribulation with the great war)

Sach 13,8 And it shall come to pass throughout all the land, saith the LORD, **two parts of it will be eradicated**, different, and **<only> the third part of it remains**.

The big question is still:

How can the Antichrist sit in the temple of God before the tribulation period if it will only be built when Jesus comes again?

The great world war takes place in the tribulation period?

Armageddon coming at the same time as Jesus' return?

The war of Gog and Magog occurs after the Millennial Kingdom when the Antichrist is released for a short time and before the final judgment?

35. Final word - Summary, summary

Check, keep the good!

1. Thess 5,21 But check everything, hold on to the good!

Revival is coming from Jerusalem!

Yes 10,21

21 A remnant of Jacob will return to the mighty God.

Yes 37,32

32 For a remnant will come out of Jerusalem, and those who escape from Mount Zion. The jealousy of the LORD of hosts will do this.

It will happen when it is time. Only God knows the exact time.

But there are enough clues in the word that allow us to recognize the signs and also the constant reminder to pay attention to the signs that are happening around us.

Several times the Bible tells us to be careful because the Lord is coming like a thief in the night!

God loves us so much that He revealed His plan to us in advance!

Now it's up to us whether we want to believe that or not.

Let us take the step voluntarily, because God does not force us because he is not a puppet

but come to him out of love.

Everyone has to take the step for themselves. Are you ready for this?

The ending is still open as to what will happen and when!

Off 3,10 Because you have kept the word of waiting for me, I also will keep you from the hour of temptation that is coming upon all the face of the earth, to try those who dwell on the earth.

Off 3,11 I am coming soon. **Hold on to what you have**, so that no one takes your victory wreath!

1.Thess 5,8-11

8 But we, who belong to the day, let us be sober, having on the breastplate of faith and love, and as a helmet the hope of salvation. 9 For God has not destined us for wrath[a], but to **achieve salvation** through our Lord Jesus Christ, 10 who died for us, so that whether we wake or sleep, **live together with him**. 11 Therefore **admonish one another and edify one another**, as you do too!
